**ORDER HOLDING DEFENDANT
FOR FURTHER PROCEEDINGS**

The parties appeared before me on August 4, 2004 for a continued preliminary examination on the complaint, which charges defendant with Mail Fraud and Money Laundering, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1341 and 1956(a)(1)(A)(i). Defendant was advised of her right to counsel, but chose to represent herself. Attorney Ray Kent, appointed standby counsel, was also present. At the hearing, the court found probable cause to bind defendant over on the charges set forth in the complaint. Accordingly:

IT IS ORDERED that defendant be and hereby is bound over for further proceedings pursuant to FED. R. CRIM. P. 5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant is committed to the custody of the Attorney General until further order of the court.
