**ORDER GRANTING IN PART MOTION
FOR ENDS OF JUSTICE CONTINUANCE**

Defendant David Albrecht has filed a motion for a 90-day ends of justice continuance of the final pretrial and trial presently scheduled for January 28, 2005 and February 7, 2005 (docket #153). The defendant's motion indicates the need for adequate time to review the thousands of documents involved in this case which involves multiple defendants and an 83-count Superseding Indictment. The motion states that the Government does not oppose the request for continuance. None of the co-defendants in this matter have stated an objection to the request for continuance.

The Court finds that the ends of justice served by the granting of the defendant's motion to adjourn, albeit for a shorter period of time than requested, outweighs the best interest of the public and the defendants in a speedy trial.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to Fed.R.Crim.P. §3161(h)(8)(B)(iv), an ends of justice continuance is hereby **GRANTED**. As to all defendants, the final pretrial conference is

rescheduled to March 25, 2005 at 8:30 a.m. and trial is rescheduled to April 18, 2005 at 9:00 a.m.
